Practical note that I had to learn myself 🙄: once the PR is opened, you should avoid force pushes. It makes reviews harder. If you need to rebase your branch (not necessary in most cases), you can merge main into the branch instead of rebasing. If you need to make changes, add commits.

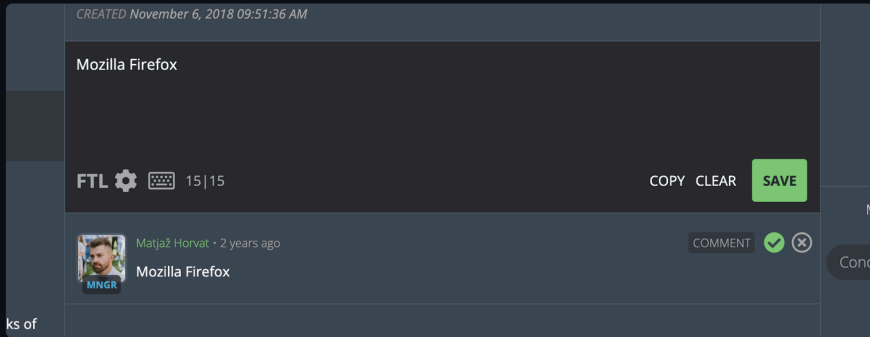

I would make the main editor background color the same as the editor toolbar background color, same as we already do in the light theme.

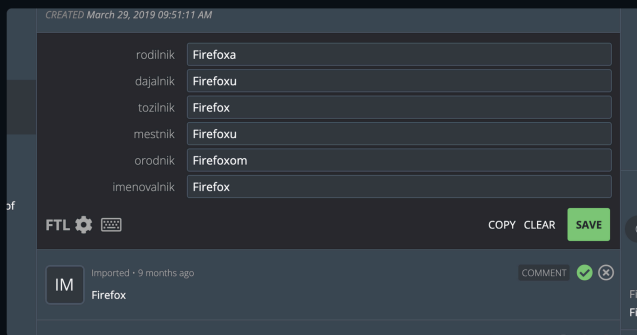
Dark:

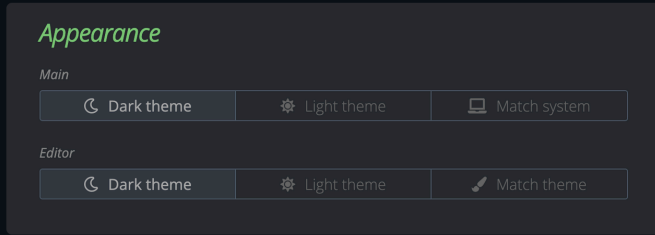
